Led by experts from academia and industry, the panel will explore **engineering ethics, educational strategies, and the intersection of public policy and pedagogy**. One confirmed panelist is a regular ASEE participant; another is local to the Montreal area; and a third, from industry, brings significant experience in university outreach.

Important Travel Information

- U.S. Citizens & Permanent Residents: No additional documentation required.
- International Attendees: Be sure to check requirements for Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) or Canadian Visa.

Register Early!

Early-bird deadline: Monday, April 28, 2025

Reminder: At least one author must register for each paper to appear on the final program. Secure hotel accommodations soon—availability is limited.

Visa Letter: Authors can request an official letter of recognition for their visa application by emailing conferences@asee.org with the following information:

- Your full name as it appears on your passport
- Your physical mailing address (where you reside)
- Your passport number
- Your passport expiration date
- The name of the country that issued the passport

Letter of Event Recognition from Canada: ASEE has provided a letter of event recognition from Canada.
