Krantz suggested National University of Singapore might be willing to host. Henry suggested holding such a meeting in conjunction with the ASEE sponsored international meeting. Krantz will request a white paper from Cutlip with more detail.

12. Polly Piergiovanni presented an appreciation plaque to Randy Lewis for his efforts in programming the 2007 meeting. A virtual pipe wrench was passed to Valerie Young from Piergiovanni. Young presented an appreciation plaque to Piergiovanni for service as chair.
