1. Call to Order and Introductions

Nancy Kruse, Chair, called the meeting to order at 7:50 a.m. Each attendee introduced themselves and gave their title and affiliation.

2. Distribution and Review of CPDD Business Meeting Minutes-ASEE-Louisville, KY, June 2010

Rita Burrell, Secretary, distributed the minutes and called for review. One correction was noted: CIEC 2012 Conference Update--the conference theme is *Expanding the Workforce Pipeline: Beyond K-12*. On motion by Greg Ruff and second by Mark Schuver, minutes were approved as amended.

3. CPDD Executive Board Activities

Nancy Kruse provided an update of CPDD Executive Board activities.

-At the fall planning meeting in October, Tulsa, OK, the Board established a Finance Committee in order to play a more active role in CIEC/ASEE activities. Members of the Finance Committee are: Paul Jewell; Mark Schuver; Greg Ruff; and Jim Brandt. Jim will also serve as Assistant CPDD Treasurer.

-CPDD was awarded one of the ASEE PIC Awards of \$500. The funds will be used to focus on increasing membership.

4. Summary of Treasurer's Report

Greg Ruff, Treasurer, presented the Treasurer's Report and provided a summary of activities.

-CPDD is fiscally sound with a balance on hand of slightly over \$53K.

-At the fall meeting, the Board requested a financial analysis of income and expenses of the Division over the past 5 years. Marketing expenses have varied over this period as have expenses when hosting CIEC. Interest income has been down. The balance has run between \$45K-\$50K over the past 5-6 years.

-With focus on increasing membership, the Board has proposed utilizing some funds for related activities.

-On motion by Kim Scalzo and second by Keith Plemmons, the Treasurer's Report was approved as distributed.

President, IACEE, noted that the organization is a forum to promote international connections between universities and business. The IACEE 2012 World Conference on Continuing Engineering Education will be held in Valencia, Spain, May 17-19, 2012.
