1. **POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT:** DEED Executive Board: Program-Chair Elect, Directors, Committee on Diversity Equity and Inclusion Liaison and Graduate Student Representative

There are several openings on the DEED Executive Board. Come join us and help prepare for next year's conference! A variety of positions are open including our Program Chair-Elect, 2 Director positions, our Liaison to the Committee on Diversity Equity and Inclusion (CDEI) and our Graduate Student Representative.

Directors – In this position you will work with the rest of the Executive Board to plan out DEED activities for the next annual conference. Directors have the ability to identify a project of interest (e.g., a special session for the conference or award competition) and take the lead on that project with the help of the board. Directors have access to a small stipend to support projects they propose. This is a 1 or 2 year position, great for getting familiar with DEED or getting involved in the conference.

Program Chair Elect – In this position you work through the ranks of the DEED leadership, starting with Program Chair Elect, Program Chair, Treasurer, Division Chair and Past Chair. The role changes each year, with Program Chair Elect starting as a shadowing position before moving into Program Chair and beyond. This is a larger commitment and benefits from past experience in DEED, other ASEE divisions or other conferences, but will let you get deeply involved and have an impact on the future of the division.

CDEI Liaison – In this position you will work as the liaison between DEED and CDEI, sharing insights, initiatives, and concerns across the two groups. This will let you get involved with DEI initiatives at ASEE and work with the DEED board on these. This position can be held for 1 or more years.

Graduate Student Representative – In this position graduate students have an opportunity to get involved with DEED and learn about how a conference is planned. You will help support the team and speak to concerns and considerations graduate students have for the conference.
