- 3. The ERM Treasurer's report was given by Teri Reed Rhoads. The current balance (as of March 31) is \$69,699.24 in the BASS account and (\$827.00) in our Operating account.
- 4. P.K. Imbrie reported that we had 8 workshops with 180 people in attendance. 27 people bought tickets for Breakfast with Champions, 59 for the ERM Business Lunch and 80 for the Brouhaha. Larry and Dan did a great job at the "ForUm & AginUm". We have a total of 14 sessions with 1 being a special session. Attendance has been between 70 and 90 people at each of the sessions. 148 abstracts were submitted for review, slightly down from 172 reported last year. 96 abstracts were accepted. 76 papers were submitted from review and 70 were accepted and published. 47% acceptance rate this year with 45% acceptance rate last year. Distinguished Lecturer candidate was again accepted and Joe Wilson is our speaker tomorrow morning at 10 a.m. 30 people were involved in abstract reviews and 90 people were involved in paper reviews. Two major changes in review process, a new review criteria was published this year and an online reviewer sign-up system was utilized. The call for papers now has this rigorous review criteria included. Thanks to Matt Ohland and Alicia Waller for sitting on this committee.
- 5. Cindy Finelli reported that the call for papers for ASEE2005 has been issued. An electronic reminder will also be sent.
- 6. Dan Moore, FIE program chair for FIE2004 reported all went well and thanks to those who helped with reviewing and other activities.
- 7. Heidi Diefes-Dux, ERM program chair for FIE2005 reported that there were 721 abstracts submitted, and 360 papers and works-in-progress have been accepted. The registration form for FIE2005, to be held in Indianapolis, is available on line.
- 8. Beth E. has been named ERM program chair for FIE2006. Susan L. is the General co-Chair of FIE2006 to be held in San Diego. Note the date changes for this year; a Saturday-Tuesday format has been chosen with the conference ending on Halloween.
- 9. The ERM website has been much improved by recent up-dates by Dan Budny. If anyone has any contributions, please send the content or link to Dan.
- 10. FIE 2008 will be held in Saratoga Springs, New York.

- 11. Doug Schmucker discussed book marks and that we have decided to cancel the ERM brochures at this time. He also solicited a volunteer for next year's person.
- 12. Apprentice Faculty Grant (AFG) recipients were introduced by AFG chair, Robin Adams. This years recipients introduced were Marcia Friesen, Jenni Light, Ken Yasuhara, and Stephen Zemke. Jennifer Karlin will head the AFG committee next year. Eric thanked Robin for her many years of service as AFG Committee Chair.
- 13. The ERM Distinguished Service Award winner for FIE2005 is Dan Budny.
- 14. Benjamin J. Dasher Best Paper Award for the best paper presented at FIE 2004 (to be presented at FIE 2005) "Grade-Point Average, Changes of Major, and Majors Selected by Students Leaving Engineering" Matt Ohland, Guili Zhang, Brian Thorndyke, and Tim Anderson.
- 15. ASEE Educational Research & Methods Division Helen Plants Award 2005 for the best non-traditional Frontiers in Education 2004 Conference session (to be presented at FIE 2005) "Feminist Frontiers" Monica Bruning, Eileen Cashman, Elizabeth Eschenbach, Susan Lord, and Alisha Waller.
- 16. Thanks to the ERM Nominating Committee of Larry R. (chair) and Rich L.
- 17. Sarah our PIC IV chair reported on the number of women in the various Divisions and ERM ranks in the top 10 for percent women participating. A sentence must be added "Upon approval of the ASEE Board" to the current by-laws and then they will be approved on Thursday, June 16. Theme for next year's conference will be *The Scholarship of Engineering Education: A Year Long Dialogue*. There were 49 more sessions requested than could be honored. The program committee is asking every Division to ask for one less session next year than this year. Emails will be sent with further details and requests for additional sessions will be made through Sarah and decisions will be made in October. Sarah was asked to take a request back to the Board that we would like for the costs of the workshops be covered with the ASEE fees so that we don't have to guess at these costs like we are currently doing.
- 18. A final version of a MOU was agreed upon at this meeting. Norman has agreed to sponsor a portion of the New Faculty Apprentice grants as a part of this MOU. This means that CASEE will become an annual event associated with FIE.
- 19. Larry Richards is new chair. Robin Adams and Jenna Carpenter were elected as Directors. Cindy Finelli now becomes the Program Chair for ASEE 2006 and Heidi Deufux-Dux is 2005 FIE. Jennifer Karlin will become AFG Chair. Don Carpenter will take on Plants Committee.
- 20. Plants and Dasher awards will become FIE awards so there will be a committee of three made up of each society.
- 21. We thanked Eric for his service as Chair of the ERM Division.
- 22. There was no Old Business.
- 23. The next ERM Business meeting will be at FIE 2005. The meeting adjourned at 1:38PM
