# **Officer and Committee Reports**

1. Chair – Elliot Douglas

#### Strategic Plan

• 5 goals, each lead by a director with Susan Lord as an appointed ad-hoc director

- directors will report to chair on progress toward goals
- obtain survey data slides from Elliot
- growing perception in the community that ERM is for engineering education researchers only (possibly a result of the growth in engineering education phd programs)
- change in the last 5 or so years in how welcoming the division is perceived
- ASEE works in progress some divisions doing it already
- setup "best of..." sessions Senay
- working group within ASEE to report on changes that the community would like to see

ERM Logo Change

- must change because looks like old ASEE logo Daniel Knight lead
- AFG Noted as open, but Jay and Micah would like to lead
- Nominating committee needs volunteers
  - Positions open include 2 directors and chair

#### 2. Co-Chair for FIE 2014 (Madrid, Spain, October 2014) Programs - Monica Cardella

Total abstract submissions: 895 Abstracts rejected: ~20 Papers submitted (all types): 699 Final Program: 520 Workshop and Special Session Proposals: 40+ (usually around 20) Attendance: 578 plus 5 walk-ins Countries represented: 48 ( 50% by US; Spain 2<sup>nd</sup> highest)

Currently a loss of \$18K, but looking for fee waiver which would result in a gain of \$7K.

- IEEE computer society charges 28K for legal fees, but waive it so that the conference doesn't have loss
- removal of a Thursday offsite reception helped with costs

Large issue with reviews not being completed - 100 or so.

Russ Meier: need to do more to welcome new people form outside the community Beth Eschenbach: steering committee is brainstorming new ideas to improve review completion

- 3. Co-Chair for FIE 2015 (El Paso, TX, Oct. 2015) Programs Senay Purzer
  - fliers available
  - if you have any suggestions for organization, etc. email Senay to address

#### 4. FIE Steering Committee – Beth Eschenbach

- momentum to have more FIE's outside the US
- considering make it more frequent
- Sweden in the near future (2019?) every 5 years
- 35% of attendance from Europe this year
- no sessions had ERM anywhere on it no association with anything at the conference
- no clear way to know how to stay involved beyond the conference
- add membership fliers in conference bags
- need to create a more international experience for everyone
- average of 600 at FIE over the past 15 years over saturation of engineering education conferences on the market
- idea of co-locating conferences
- costs will never lower based on location because it's hard to recover
- IEEE cannot charge life members more than students

- impact factor
  - o 45-55% acceptance rate
  - A ranking for Australia
  - B ranking for Europe
  - H-index of 12
  - impact factor 1.22 or so

### 5. IEEE Education Society Program Co-Chair - Russ Meier

- other societies having issues with filling positions
- responsibility of presidents
- now Russ and Arnold's responsibility to make those appointments as VP of Conferences
- ERM and Computer society will no longer have to subsidize the awards banquet
- 6. Benjamin Dasher Award Committee Jenefer Husman
  - last year as Dasher
  - Noemi Mendoza is replacement next year
  - 2015 chaired by computer science group, cycle back to ERM next year (Noemi was noted as chair though...needs to be corrected)
  - entire committee will be new next year
  - how does chair access nominated papers currently done through back channels
  - how do we improve nomination process

### 7. Helen Plants Award Committee - Marisa Orr

- 6 special sessions (2013) Award winner: The Lord of the PhD, etc. Jay, Stephanie, Matthew, and Lauren
- not notified until after FIE abstracts deadline need to know sooner because winner gets free trip
- no rep from IEEE education currently on the committee
- 10 special sessions (2014) much larger pool to begin with
- 9 mini-workshops not included in award process; what's the difference?
- issue of submitting as special session and being listed as mini-workshop (only special sessions currently qualify for the award). Should the award include mini-workshops and panel sessions?
- need to update naming convention for submissions and the program
- will number of sessions need to be limited if all special sessions and mini-workshops are included in evaluation
- max would be 22
