We are drawing on a local educator pool, including formal and informal educators from pre-schools to technical high schools, museums, camps, and classrooms. Our local partners include PSU, <u>Portland Metro STEM Partnership</u>, and <u>Oregon MESA</u>. This year, we will pilot a program for engineering faculty to learn from the conference as well, expanding opportunities for ASEE members to learn about teacher professional development and engineering outreach.
