



ASEE Southeastern Section Thomas C. Evans Engineering Education Paper Award

Purpose: The Thomas C. Evans Engineering Education Paper Award is given to the author or authors of the most outstanding paper pertaining to engineering education.

Award: The award includes a certificate and a \$1000 cash prize, which are presented at the annual Section meeting.

Eligibility: The author or authors must be members of the ASEE Southeastern Section.

Nomination: A colleague, department head, or student may nominate a paper for this award.

Qualifications: The winning paper will be chosen from one of the following categories:

1. Unpublished papers
2. Papers published in refereed journals during the previous calendar year
3. Papers published in conference proceedings during the previous calendar year

The successful candidate must attend the annual Section meeting at which the cash prize and certificate are presented. The successful candidate will also present their paper at the annual Section meeting.

Documentation: Nominations and submissions will be accepted through **January 31, 2021**.
