Proposal Submission Guidelines

If you have a suggestion for a discussion topic (a Roundtable) or an innovation to increase student learning or instructor communication (an Active) you can submit an abstract to host a 1hour Roundtable/Active at <u>http://se.asee.org/Conference/Default.htm.</u> The abstract should be no more than 350 words and should include

- Session title
- Host name(s)and affiliation
- Session goals
- Brief description of engagement topic and interactive activity
- Required technology and/or software needs for participants
- Date(s) you absolutely CANNOT host the Roundtable/Active
