Student Poster Competition

The Southeastern Section of the American Society for Engineering Education (ASEE) hosts a **Student Poster Competition** at each annual Section Conference. The competition is the only venue through which undergraduate students can present their **technical research** at the conference.

Divisions

Students may submit a poster in the following categories:

- Lower-Division Team (First-Year and Second-Year/Freshmen and Sophomore)
- Upper-Division Team (Third-Year and Fourth-Year/Junior and Senior)
- Individual Undergraduate Research

Teams are categorized based on the classification of the highest-ranking member of their team.

Abstract and Poster Submission

The Southeastern Section of ASEE uses OpenConf, an abstract management and peer-review system, to manage poster submissions. To submit an extended abstract or poster navigate to: https://papers.asee-se.org/.

Eligibility and Registration

Student attendees at the conference may register at a reduced rate of \$50. Student registration includes breakfast, lunch, and dinner at the Awards Banquet on Monday. In addition, students may attend the Welcome Reception on Sunday. However, student registration does not include breakfast or lunch on Tuesday.

- 1. Each entry to the Student Poster Competition must have a faculty advisor that is **registered at the conference**.
 - a. A faculty advisor may sponsor no more than three entries.
- 2. A student submitting to the Individual Division must register for the conference as a Student Attendee.
- 3. For entries to the **Lower- or Upper-Division**, **at least two** team members must register for the conference as Student Attendees.
