Meritorious Award David E. Goldberg

David E. Goldberg is a professor emeritus of the University of Illinois who continues to contribute to engineering education, and higher education more broadly, as a scholar, consultant, and career coach. Author of several books, including the influential *A Whole New Engineer* (2014) and the new *A Field Manual for a Whole New Higher Education*, both co-authored with Mark Somerville, Goldberg is a tireless champion of improving engineering education.

He is a founder of the Forum on Philosophy, Engineering, & Technology (fPET). Collaborating internationally, Goldberg has organized workshops and forums, biennially, since 2007 continuing through 2023, without the sponsorship of a larger structure, such as a society, to support that effort. That effort has resulted directly in the publication of a book series on Philosophy and Engineering, and fostered countless conversations, elevating our particular area of engineering education research. His work has influenced our division, and we continue to benefit from the philosophers he has attracted to connect with engineering and technological subjects.
