- ⌘ Material samples collection







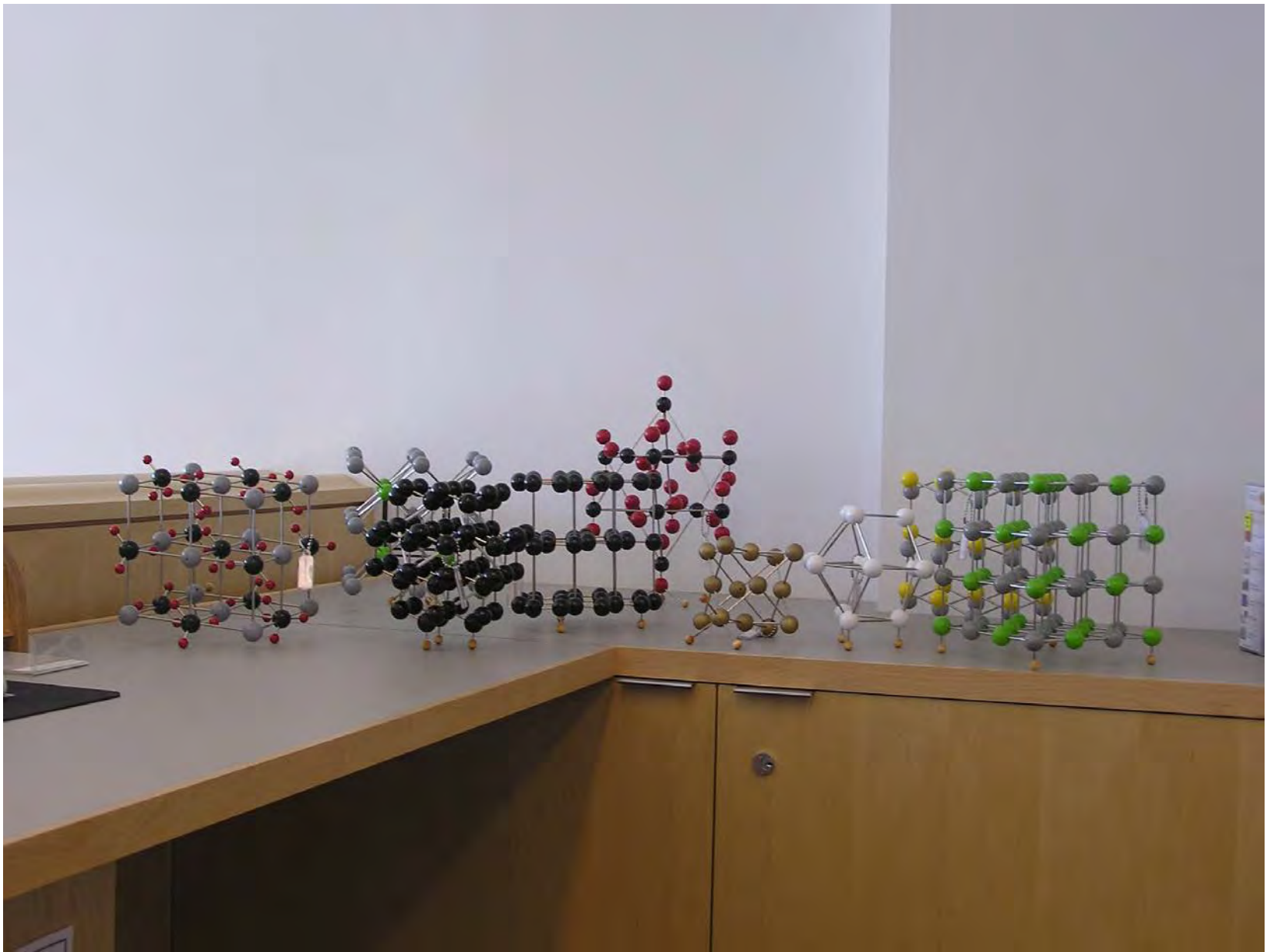












Olin College Library - Services
