Greenstone customization CGI

cgi arguments used by library encode the parameters of each page, e.g., what kind of page to display, what query to carry out. **a** is the main cgi argument and determines which action is used to display the page.

1 a=p: Page action

2 a=q: Query action

3 a=d: Document action

4 a=extlink: External Link action

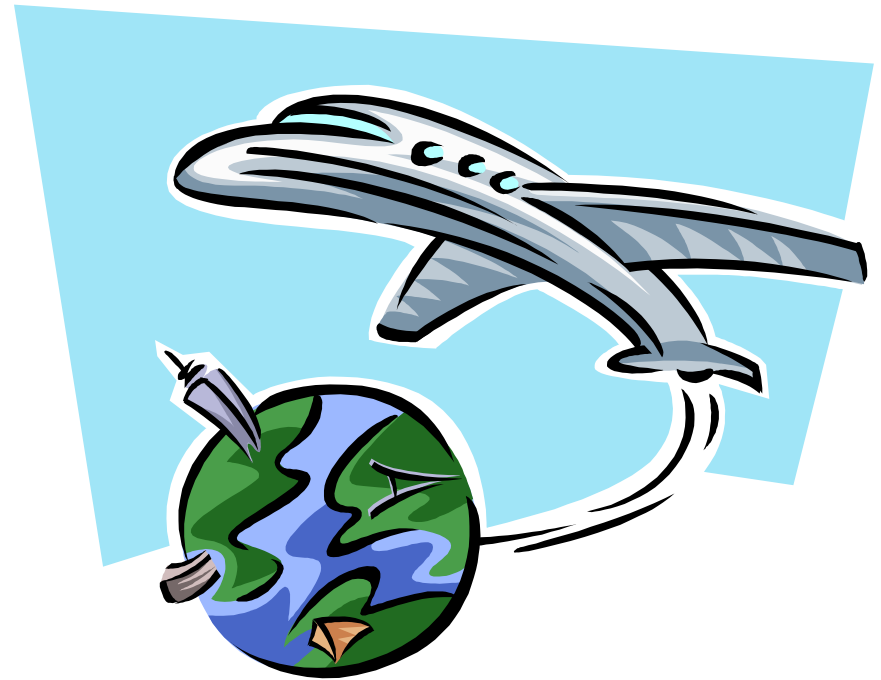

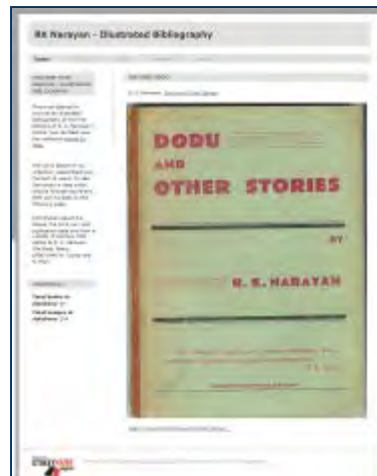



About this collection

Published by the University of Hawaii Press in 1983, "Building a Rainbow" is about the history of the buildings and grounds of the University of Hawaii at Manoa's campus. Edited by Victor Kobayashi, the book comprises of articles and stories by students and faculty of University of Hawaii at Manoa.

At the time that the book was published, metal lithographic plates were utilized to produce the limited quantity of books. These plates have long since been discarded and there are no existing electronic back-up copies of the books. "Building a Rainbow" will not be reproduced. Present existing copies of the books in the University of Hawaii Libraries' are deteriorating with each use. The glue used to bind the book is weakening, causing the pages of the books to detach from the spine each time the book is opened. The digitization of "Building a Rainbow" is an effort to preserve the contents of the book yet at the same reach a wider audience.


The "Building a Rainbow" Digital Library was part of a system analysis project done in Dr. Luz Quiroga's LIS 647 System Analysis for Information Management in the spring semesters of 2007. The resulting digital library's layout and data structure is the product of the term project, "Digitizing 'Building a Rainbow'". The members of the project were Nadia Ayesh, Amy Irie, Alice Tran, and Tamara Zielinski.

The Trust Territory Archives Photograph Collection is a unique resource of 50,000 photographs and 2,000 slides that documents the history of the American period in Micronesia (1947-1988), and includes invaluable visual representations of island cultures. Much of this material was salvaged from the former Trust Territory Headquarters on Saipan, and owes its very existence to the persistence of former Trust Territory Archivist Sam McPhetres and his team, who were engaged in microfilming the files of the American administration.




The Social Movements Collection consists of pamphlets, brochures, and periodicals about the labor movement in the United States as well as global radical political movements, including anarchism, communism, and fascism. The bulk of this collection was acquired by the University of Hawaii at Manoa Library in 1966 from Eugene Bechtold, a bookseller and former instructor at the Chicago Workers' School. Mr. Bechtold began collecting this material in the 1920s. The collection also includes items from the collection of John Reineke.

There are approximately 10,000 items in the collection. Approximately 3,000 items have been cataloged so far. Many of the items are very fragile and need preservation. This Web page is the first part of a pilot project to preserve, catalog and make available this important resource.



WELCOME TO HAWAIIAN MUSIC COLLECTION

Welcome to the demo of the Hawaiian Music Collection.

In 2002, the library acquired the Hawaiian music collection of Dirk Vogel who had been collecting Hawaiian music since the 1920s. The collection contains 6,000 78s, 2,650 LPs, 900 45s and thousands of other items.

Also in 2002, the Library received a bequest of 2,533 Hawaiian music recordings from the estate of James Grant Cathro of Glasgow, Scotland, who died in 1999. Mr. Cathro collected the recordings, with special interest in steel guitar music, over the course of many years. The collection contains 2,056 phonodiscs (33-1/3, 45 and 78 RPM speeds); 236 cassettes and various other recordings.



Welcome to the Steve Thomas TRADITIONAL MICRONESIAN NAVIGATION COLLECTION.

The Steve Thomas Traditional Micronesian Navigation Collection is comprised of unpublished papers, audiovisual and photographic materials (including oral history transcripts and 35mm slides), publications and miscellaneous items related primarily to traditional navigation on the island of Satawal Island, Yap.

ORIGIN OF THE COLLECTION

As a young man piloting a small sailboat across the Pacific, Steve Thomas developed a fascination with ancient methods of navigation. He learned of a seafaring culture which 6,000 years ago, used arcane navigation arts to guide initiates unerringly across the Pacific with no compasses, no charts. Thomas ventured to the tiny coral atolls of Micronesia in search of these mysteries, this ancient language of the sea. There he found the last navigator, Mau Pailug, one of the last surviving "palu", belongs to a dying breed of navigators who used only natural signs - stars, waves, birds - to guide their sailing canoes across thousands of miles of open ocean.

Steve is the author of Last Navigator and creator of the film of the same name. He has donated his amazing collection of slides of Satawal (Micronesia), including canoes, island scenes, feasts, dancing, traditional arts to the Pacific Collection, University of Hawaii at Manoa

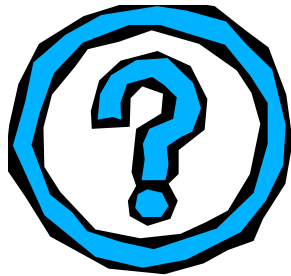
