- New technology, tools or products

Each Member Talk is 3 minutes, and each Sponsor Talk is 1 minute. The main goals are to learn about what our peers and sponsors are currently working on, and to generate discussions during the session and over the course of the conference.

Your proposal should include:

- Your name, email, title and organization
- Title of talk
- Type of talk (Member or Sponsor)
- Brief description of your talk (no more than 100 words)
