#### 2023 FYEE Conference

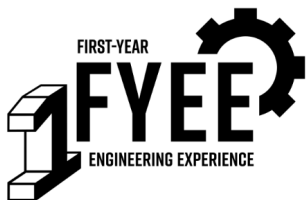
July 31/Aug 1 in Knoxville, TN!
