

## **ASCE Student Paper Competition**

### *Thinking Globally, Acting Locally*

**Competition Overview:** This is a formal invitation to participate in a student paper competition hosted by ASCE. In 4-8 pages, submissions ought to address the role of the engineer in meeting the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Think VISION. Papers addressing multidisciplinary (engineering & non-engineering) approaches to addressing UN SDGs are especially encouraged. Specifically, topics of interest include:

- METHODOLOGY
  - Situation Analysis: Current and Future Issues
  - Urbanization, Energy Supply and Transportation Construction
  - Sustainable Development and Competitiveness
- TECHNOLOGY
  - Innovation and Sustainable Infrastructure
  - Sustainable Materials, Tools and Methodologies
- FINANCE
  - Financing Infrastructure Projects
- POLICY
  - Sustainable Cities, Society and Culture
  - Urbanization and Sustainable Construction
- EDUCATION
  - Sustainable Cities and Engineering Education

**Submission Deadline:** Your papers must be submitted by January 15, 2017, 5:00pm EST.

**Review Process:** A team of sustainability educators and researchers on ASCE's Committee on Sustainability subcommittee on Formal Engineering Education will review your full paper submissions. You will be notified of acceptance by January 30, 2017.

**Finalists:** The top three finalists will be invited to present at the ASCE International Conference on Sustainable Infrastructure in New York, NY during October 2017. Your submissions will have potential to be published within the proceedings, and travel to the conference will potentially be funded. **Conference Presentation:** At the conference, you will have 5 minutes to present your paper. The final hour of the presentation will feature you within a roundtable discussion format.
