#3 - Important **2022 Conference Program Chair updates:**

The Pre College Engineering Education (PCEE) Division of ASEE seeks abstracts for papers to be presented at the **ASEE Annual Conference in Minneapolis, Minnesota on June 26–29, 2022.**

The Division provides a rich and vibrant forum for the exchange of ideas, research, and experiences in pre-college engineering education. By "pre-college engineering education," we mean engineering education that directly impacts preschool through high school instruction in either formal or informal learning environments.

Abstract submission for the 2022 [ASEE Annual Conference](#) is now open. Important deadlines are [posted here](#) under the paper management tab. The **deadline to submit abstracts is Monday, November 8th**. This year there is a new paper management system called Slayte so be prepared to navigate a new platform when submitting.

#5 - Year of Impact on Racial Equity (YIRE) Pillars from Katey Shirey:

- Pillar 1: Engineering Students** YIRE is sponsoring a 90-day student design contest for undergraduates to kick off on Martin Luther King, Jr. day, Monday, January 17, 2022. Student groups from local chapters of engineering professional society will identify, define, and design a solution to an on-campus racial equity problem to improve their community. We invite you to recruit students on your campus to participate. More information will be shared soon!
- Pillar 2: Faculty and Administrators** You are invited to get involved in the following areas of focus are: contingent faculty; workload, promotion, and pay; retention and self-care; identifying racist structures; supporting underrepresented faculty; faculty mentorship of diverse graduate students; creating inclusive classrooms; learning from existing programs; divesting from white supremacy culture. - **Pillar 3: Pre-college Parents & Guardians** (1) Engineering undergraduate student stories: ASEE is spreading the word about undergraduate engineering in a "A Day in the Life" videos. These will be shared as early as the winter. So far, we have students from University of Maryland-Baltimore Campus and University of Colorado who will make videos, but we'd be happy to have more!
